

A WORD ABOUT OUR Worship

Until further notice, precautions are being taken to ensure the safety of our worshipers. There is a process for entering the building and participating in worship that we ask you to follow:

- All worshipers are asked to enter through the KITCHEN DOOR ONLY. The door will either be propped open or held open by one individual.
- Masks and hand sanitizer will be available on the tables for your use. (You may also bring your own if you'd prefer.)
- Seating will be limited to every other pew. We ask that you limit seating in each pew to 2 people, observing social distancing, or 1 family per pew.
- The liturgy will be spoken, and, while there will be music, there will be no group singing.
- There will be no handing out of bulletins, no sharing of the peace, no passing of offering plates, and no pastoral greeting at the door. Please take a bulletin from the table in the back of the church and place your offering in the basket either before or after worship.
- Communion will be done by station. As you come forward, please maintain appropriate distance. When you arrive at the station, take the bread from the pastor, and a pre-filled glass of wine or white grape juice.
- BEFORE CONSUMING THE ELEMENTS, RETURN TO YOUR PEW AND BE SEATED. ALL OF US WILL COMMUNE AT THE SAME TIME WHEN INSTRUCTED BY THE PASTOR. The blessing will follow.
- When leaving the sanctuary at the conclusion of worship, deposit your used communion cup in the basket on the table in the kitchen, maintain the appropriate social distance, and leave by the same door (kitchen) you entered.
